9:45 Stop 1 – Visit plantation, 1st entry thinning in a softwood stand as part of an uneven age conversion.

11:00 Stop 2 – Explore a past high-graded hardwood site currently running heavy to beech. Discuss management options and long-term objectives.

12:00 Lunch stop at Caribou bog bridge. Discuss landscape-scale history. Explore settlement remains.

1:00 Stop 3 – Depart for active harvest off Caribou Pitt Rd. Discuss changing harvest history, including revisiting the slot harvesting method popularized in the early 2000s.

2:15 Stop 4 – Visit a fresh harvest in a hardwood to mixedwood transitional forest, some of which is a first entry for AMC.

3:15 Drive out to the KI checkpoint.

4:00 Optional tour of Katahdin Ironworks and charcoal ironworks history
