Priorities:

- Covenants restricting cutting of live trees in subdivision ordinance
 - o Adding recommendation to create firewise communities
 - o ½ acre around homesite where you can cut and the rest is restricted
- Cross-jurisdictional agreements
- Widening right-of-way
- Livestock evacuation plan or system (backcountry horseman)
- Reverse 911 and addressing. Bluewater acres had a code red and it never reached them. Cooperative agreement between Cibola and McKinley county where addressing is done across counties.

- Roads and infrastructure
- Easement roads in Cebolla Trails and Oso ridge area. Roads were never created and are not county maintained. Load limits are not identified throughout the county so getting equipment may not be possible.
- Communication is “shakey at best”
 - o Repeater at Candy Kitchen substation possibly moved to higher ground to improve communication.
 - o Possible grant for 3 more repeaters
 - Dustin has google overlay of repeater locations
