- ~ Mandatory overnight training in August (1-2 weeks)
- ~ Will supervise 4 Crew Members.
- ~ Pay rate: \$17.75/hour
- ~ Positions open in Mountainair and Espanola
- ~ No-cost housing available in Mountainair.

#### **DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS**

- ~ Experience in a leadership position working with youth.
- ~ Ability to perform strenuous work outdoors for long hours in rough country and inclement weather.
- ~ Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- ~ Ability to work independantly.
- ~ Pass a background check.
- ~ Possess a valid drivers license and safe driving record.
- ~ Experience performing natural resouce management projects
- ~ Must have previous outdoor leadership experience.
- ~ Preferred candidate will be a qualified Wildland FFT2. Greater preference will be given to candidates qualified as FFT1 and/or that have previous wildland firefighting experience.
- ~ Must be able to pass an arduous pack test.
