The Forest Stewards Guild is hiring crew leads in Mountainair, Mt. Taylor/Grants, Pueblo of Jemez, Las Vegas, and Coyote, New Mexico to work alongside Forest Service and Natural Resource Department employees! Applications open February 12th.



Learn about conservation and leadership while helping your local community and getting paid!



Requirements:

- Available for position from June 3rd- August 9th.
- Available for mandatory overnight training June 3rd-6th, and 10th-13th.
- Able to work Mon.-Fri.
- Be a New Mexico resident and older than 18

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience in a leadership position working with youth.
- Able to perform strenuous work outdoors for long hours in rough country and inclement weather.
- Able to work independently.
- Possess a valid drivers license and safe driving record.
- Experience performing natural resource management projects.

What to expect:

FSYC provides an opportunity for youth in rural New Mexico communities to connect with their landscape and prepare for future employment. FSYC crew leads will supervise 4 members (ages 16-25) while completing natural resource management projects and receiving training and mentorship from USFS, NRD, and Forest Stewards Guild. Hourly pay is \$18.00 for crew leads, with additional benefits, No-cost housing is available in Mountainair. FSYC leads will receive CPR/WFA certification and earn 2 college credits from Santa Fe Community College.
