Requirements:

- Available for position from June 1st to July 31st.
- Available for overnight training June 1st to 5th.
- Able to work Monday-Friday.
- Be a New Mexico resident between the ages of 16 and 25
- Be physically fit and able to work long days in the field under difficult conditions (heat, sun, rain, steep uneven terrain).

What to expect:

FSYC provides an opportunity for youth in rural New Mexico communities to connect with their landscape and prepare for future employment. FSYC participants complete natural resource management projects and receive training and mentorship from USFS, NRD, and Forest Stewards Guild employees. Hourly pay is \$17.00 for crew members and \$19.00 for crew leads. In addition, FSYC participants will receive CPR/First Aid certification and the opportunity to earn 2 college credits from Santa Fe Community College.
